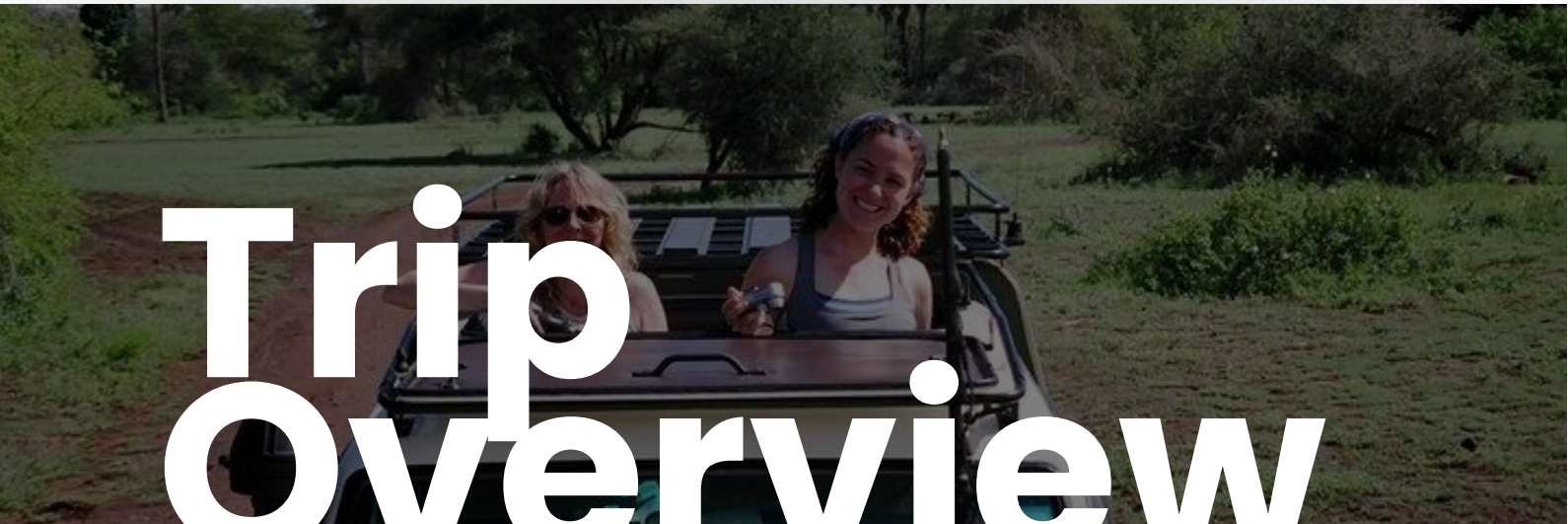

Day 01

Walking Level: Relaxed

Highlights: Hotel check-in, beach and pool relaxation

Transfers: Airport to hotel transfer

Welcome to Zanzibar. After clearing customs, meet our representative in the waiting area and transfer to your hotel. The day is free for you to settle in the hotel and relax. |

Pace of Travel: Relaxed

Steps to Walk: Approx. 2,000 steps

Facilities: Spa, beach, swimming pool, dining options

Suitable for Age group: All ages

What to Bring: Light clothing, swimwear, sunscreen, personal toiletries

What to Do: Relax and enjoy the resort amenities; take a swim in the beach or pool

What not to Do: Overexert yourself, as this is a day for relaxation

Tip for You: Take some time to adjust to the tropical climate and rest after your flight

Transfers: Airport to hotel transfer is included

Day 02

Walking Level: Moderate

Highlights: Spice plantations, Stone Town historic sites

Transfers: Hotel to tours and back

After breakfast at 09:00 am, depart for a full day Spice and City Tours with packed lunch. You shall be picked up ex Hotel for Tours. Guaranteed to waken your senses. Visit spice plantations where you will have the opportunity to pick, smell & savour fruit & spices that you have probably never seen on the supermarket shelf. Commencing at the ruins of the Maruhubi Palace, via the site of David Livingston's house (one of Africa's greatest explorers) the journey continues north toward the Kidichi Persian Baths. From here we continue to the rural areas were local farmers live & produce some of the world's most exotic fruit and spices. Cloves, star fruit, 'bull's heart', tangerine trees, lemon grass, mangosteen and lip-stick trees, to name but a few, are what you can expect to see – according to the seasons. Perhaps you will fancy buying a basket of freshly picked spices to take home with you!

01:00 pm – You shall be picked up ex Hotel for Stone town tour. Begin with a visit to Zanzibar's colourful market, alive with the buzz of locals bartering fresh vegetables and baskets of tropical fruit, cocoa farm, amongst the heady smell of exotic fruit. Continue to the site of a cathedral built in 1874. The cathedral signifies a potent time in Zanzibar's history and stands on the sight of a past slave market with the high altar standing on the exact site of the whipping post. Slavery was abolished in 1873 by decree of the Sultan of Zanzibar. From here visit the residence of the late Sultan of Zanzibar, 'Tip House', the Old Fort, 'Peoples Palace' and the House of Wonders', Forodhani garden full of intrigue from days of long ago. The tour ends with a stroll down the narrow streets of the old Stone Town, the heart of Zanzibar's chequered history. In the evening 17:00Hrs return to your hotel. |

Pace of Travel: Moderate

Steps to Walk: Approx. 6,000 steps

Facilities: Spice plantations, historical landmarks, and markets

Suitable for Age group: All ages, but moderate walking involved

What to Bring: Comfortable walking shoes, camera, hat, sunscreen, water bottle

What to Do: Explore spice plantations and Stone Town, visit historical landmarks

What not to Do: Rush through the tours, as there's much to explore

Tip for You: Wear comfortable shoes for walking through Stone Town's narrow streets

Overnight: Zanzibar

Meal: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner

Transfers: Hotel to tours and back

Day 03

Walking Level: Relaxed

Highlights: Giant tortoises, snorkeling, beach relaxation

Transfers: Hotel to Prison Island and back

After breakfast, you can relax and enjoy the activities in the hotel. In the afternoon at 14:00Hrs you shall be picked up ex Hotel for Prison Island. A trip to Prison Island in a small wooden motorized boat is a must when visiting Zanzibar. The island once used for the detention of recalcitrant slaves is now watched over by giant tortoises, some over 100 years old. The beach is superb and the crystal clear sea excellent for swimming, snorkelling, fishing and diving; a perfect way to relax. In the evening at 17:00Hrs return to your hotel. |

Pace of Travel: Relaxed

Steps to Walk: Approx. 1,500 – 2,000 steps

Facilities: Beach activities, swimming, snorkelling, boat ride

Suitable for Age group: All ages, great for families

What to Bring: Swimwear, snorkel gear (if preferred), camera, sunscreen, water shoes

What to Do: Swim, snorkel, relax on the beach, and see the giant tortoises

What not to Do: Litter or disturb the tortoises on the island

Tip for You: Enjoy the clear waters and take your time on the island, it's a peaceful place

Overnight: Zanzibar

Meal: Breakfast, Lunch, and Dinner

Transfers: Hotel to Prison Island and back

Day 04

Walking Level: Relaxed

Highlights: Morning relaxation, departure preparations

Transfers: Hotel to airport/ferry transfer

After breakfast, bid farewell to Zanzibar and transfer to airport/ferry to home. |

What to Do: Check out, relax while waiting for your transfer

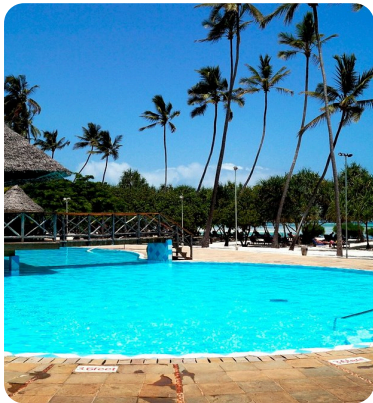
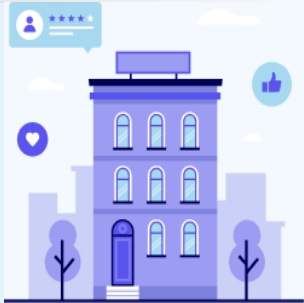
What not to Do: Forget to check your travel documents
